## **ITHIHAAS INTERNSHIPS**

Dear Students

This year, ITHIHAAS has partnered with three major museums- **the Election Museum, the National Gandhi Museum, and the National Museum**-and has devised a programme that promises to be both exciting and educational, and will give students the opportunity to work at, and contribute to some of the country's most reputed organisations.

This project is a great opportunity for students who are interested in experiencing learning, and are willing to spend the summer committed to this cause. Students will have the privilege of working with other committed young leaders on some exciting, challenging projects. They shall also have the opportunity to meet with important heritage leaders, and be mentored by them during the course of the internship.

The following are the internship programmes being offered by **ITHIHAAS**:-

### **1) The Summer Project at the Election Museum:**

About the programme: Students will work in groups to uncover and unpack terms such as democracy, elections, voting rights and citizenship. This is your opportunity to contribute to a new museum and to learn about the voting process.

Duration: 7 Days

Dates: 25<sup>th</sup> May to 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2018.

Eligible Classes: 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>

Cost of Internship Programme: 1800 INR per Student (cover all project costs, i.e. project printing and design, multimedia and equipment costs, and content)

### **2) Summer Project at the National Museum**

About the programme: This internship will provide students with an opportunity to interact with some unique specimens of our country's heritage, and the people who work to conserve and protect our heritage and museum.

Duration: 9 Days

Dates: 8<sup>th</sup> June to 16<sup>th</sup> June (Tentative)

Eligible Classes: 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>

Cost of the Internship Programme: 1800 INR per student (cover all project costs, i.e. project printing and design, multimedia and equipment costs, and content)

### **3) The Ali Naqvi Summer programme:**

About the programme: This internship programme will help the students in understanding the rights of the citizen. It is a moving programme that includes one of the oldest police stations, the Patiala House Courts and the Supreme Court Museum.

Duration: 5 Days

Dates: 21st to 24th May 2018

Cost: 1500 INR Per Student

Eligible Classes: 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>
